Please be aware that federal and state law allows healthcare providers 30 days to respond to written requests for records.

Federal and state laws allow a fee to be charged for copying patient records and I will be responsible for the payment of such fees, unless the records are sent directly to a physician or healthcare facility. I have read the information provided on this release form and do hereby acknowledge that I am familiar with and fully understand the terms and conditions of this authorization. Prohibition of re-disclosure: This form does not authorize re-disclosure of medical information beyond the limits of this consent. Where information has been disclosed from records protected by federal law for alcohol/drug abuse records or by state law for mental health records, and HIV/AIDS tests results, federal requirements (42 CFR Part2) and state requirements (IA Code ch.228&ch.141) (740 III. Comp. Stat. § 110/5) (Wis. Code §§252.15(6), 50.30) prohibit further disclosure without the specific written consent of the patient, or as otherwise permitted by such law and/or regulations. A general authorization for release of medical or other information is not sufficient for these purposes.
